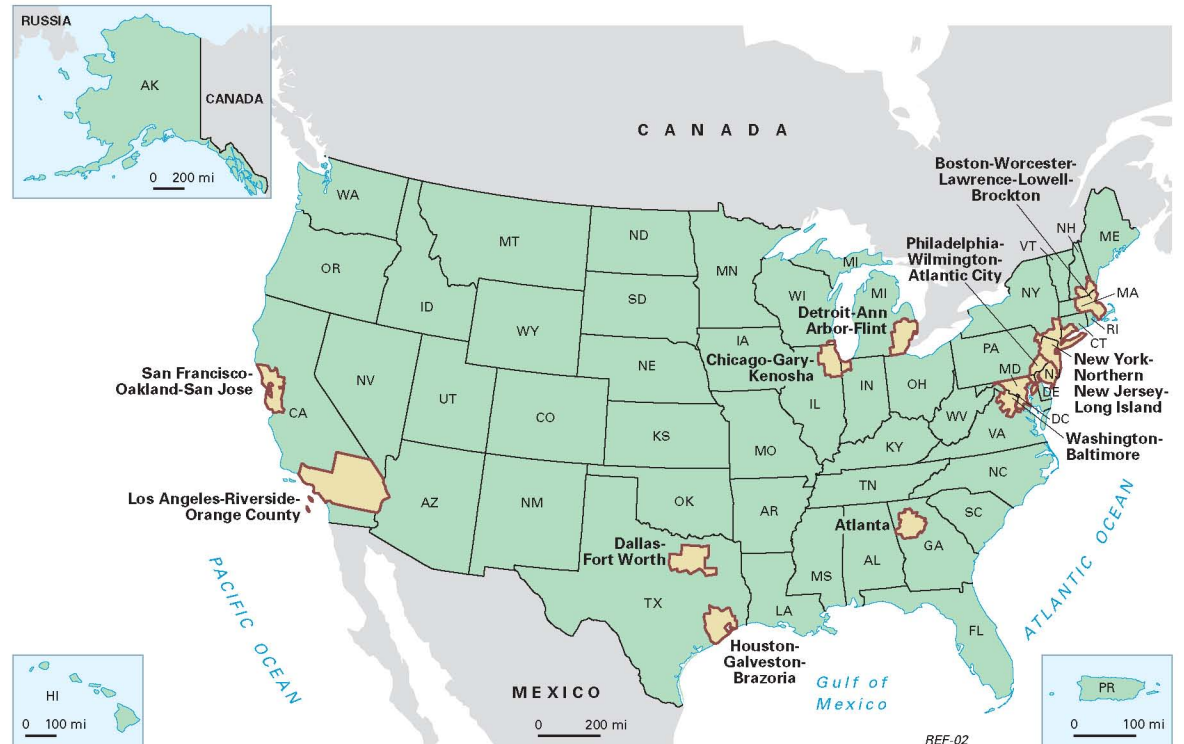


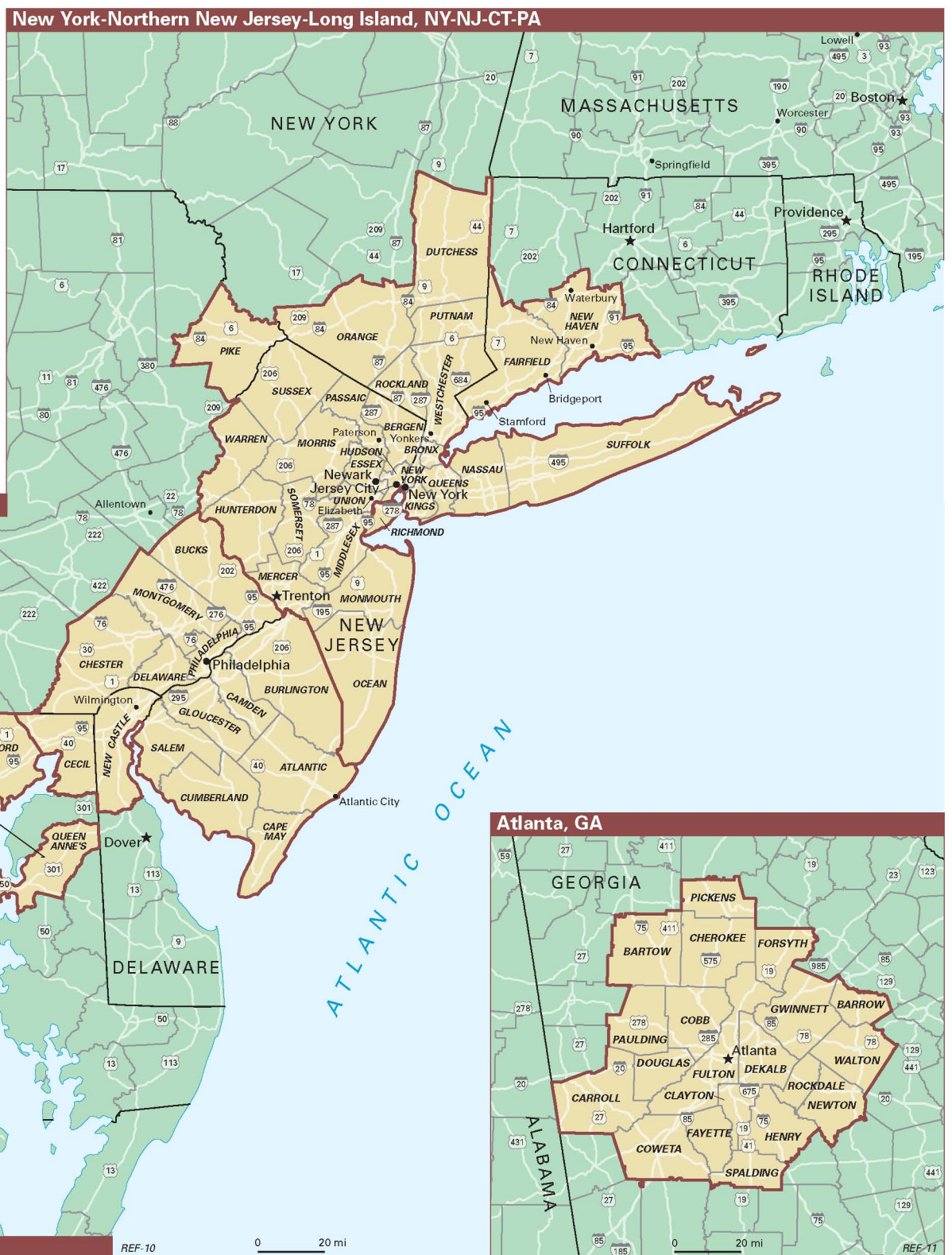
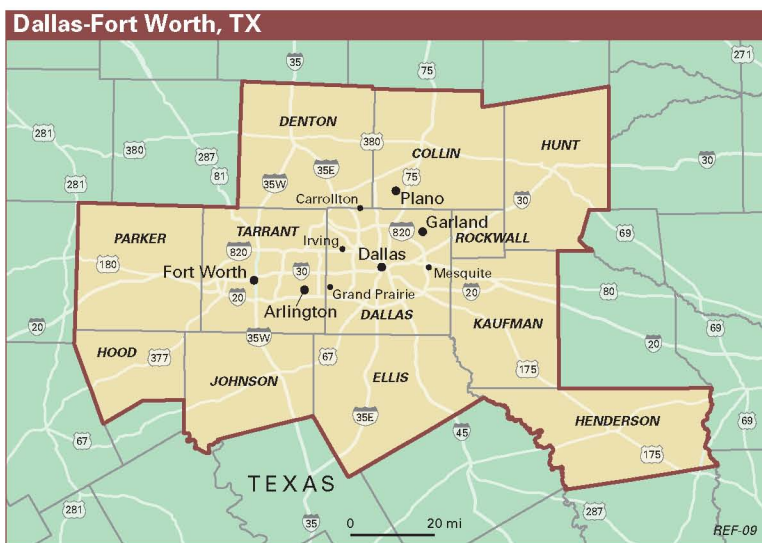


**Largest Metropolitan Areas, 2000**

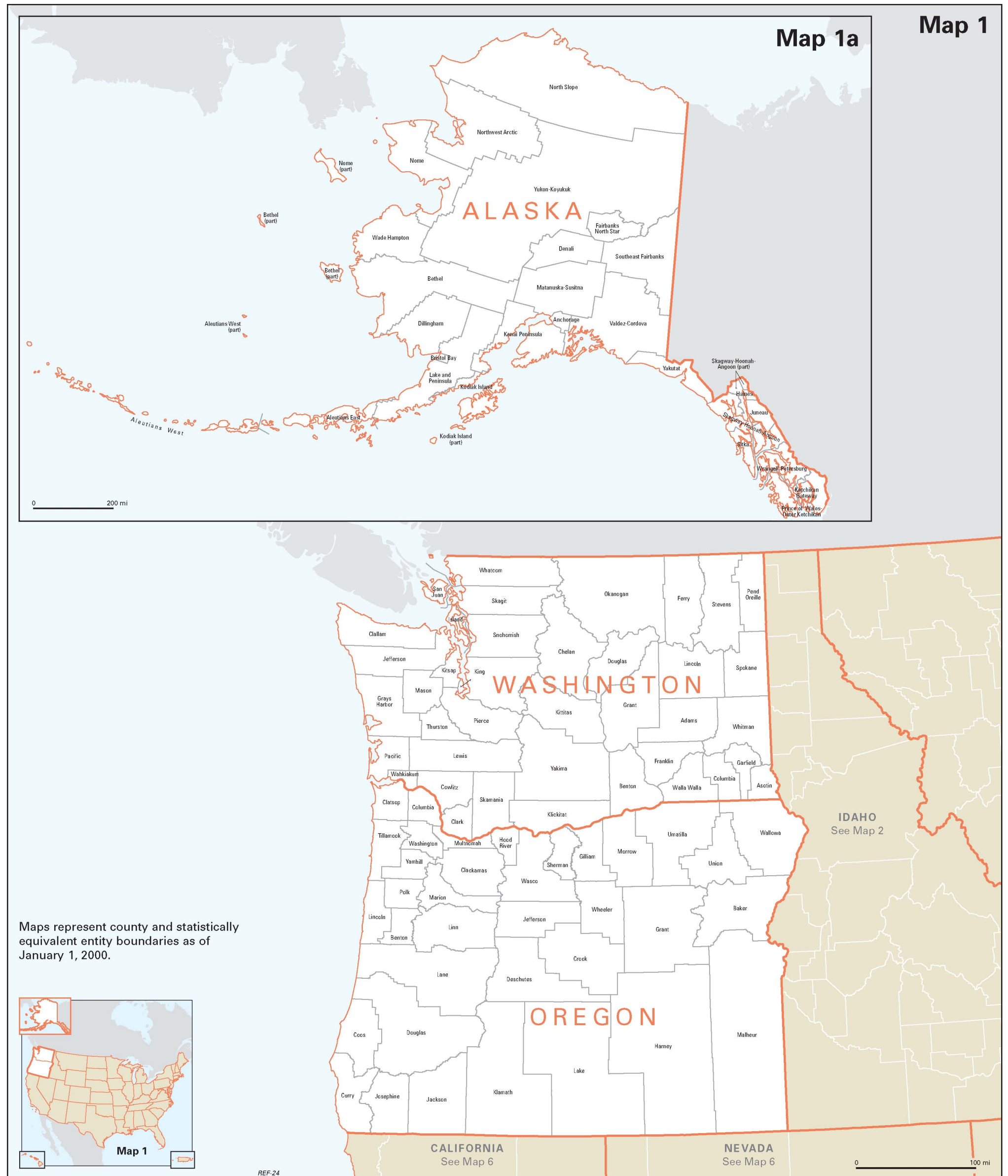

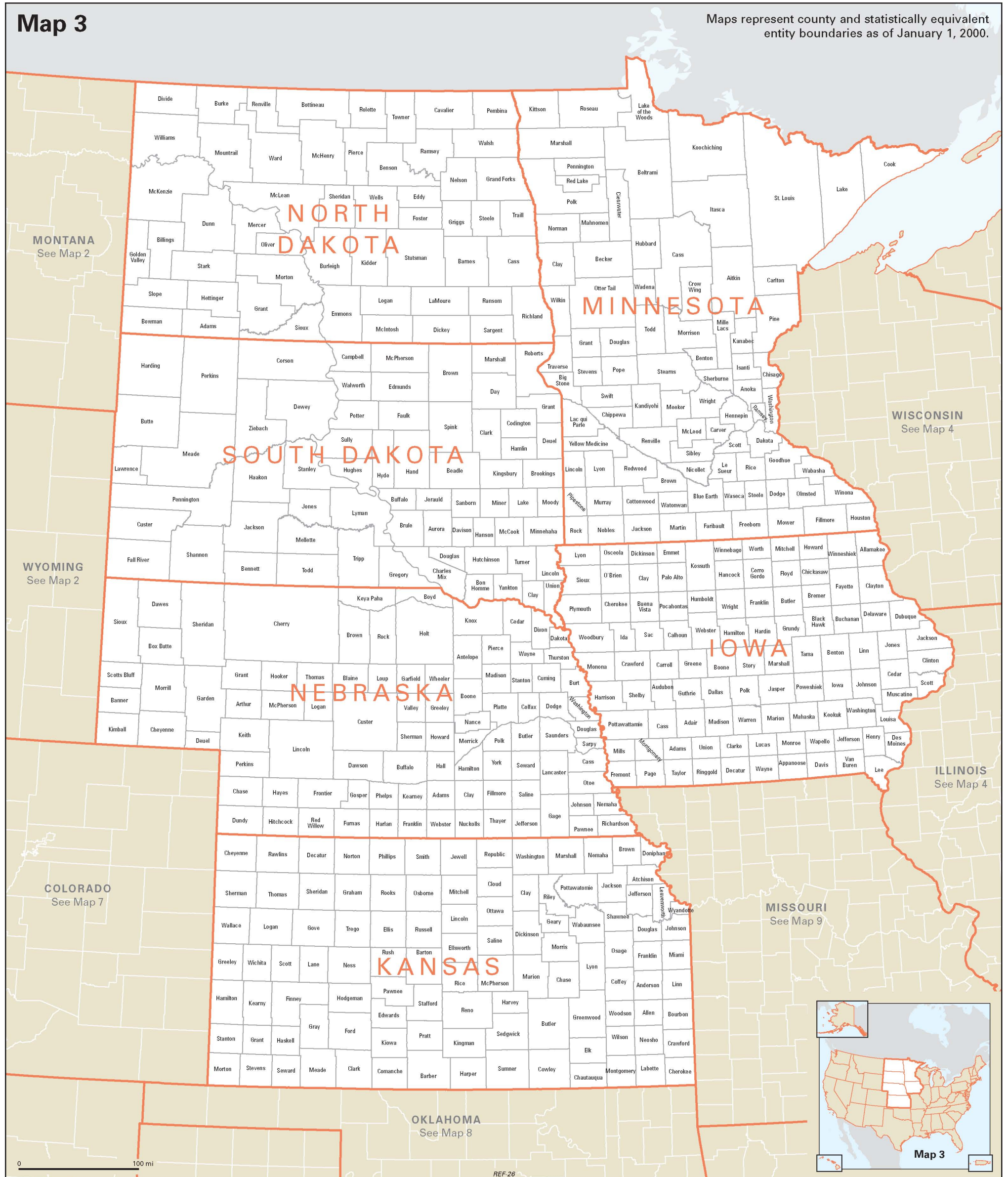

Maps represent county and statistically equivalent entity boundaries as of January 1, 2000.



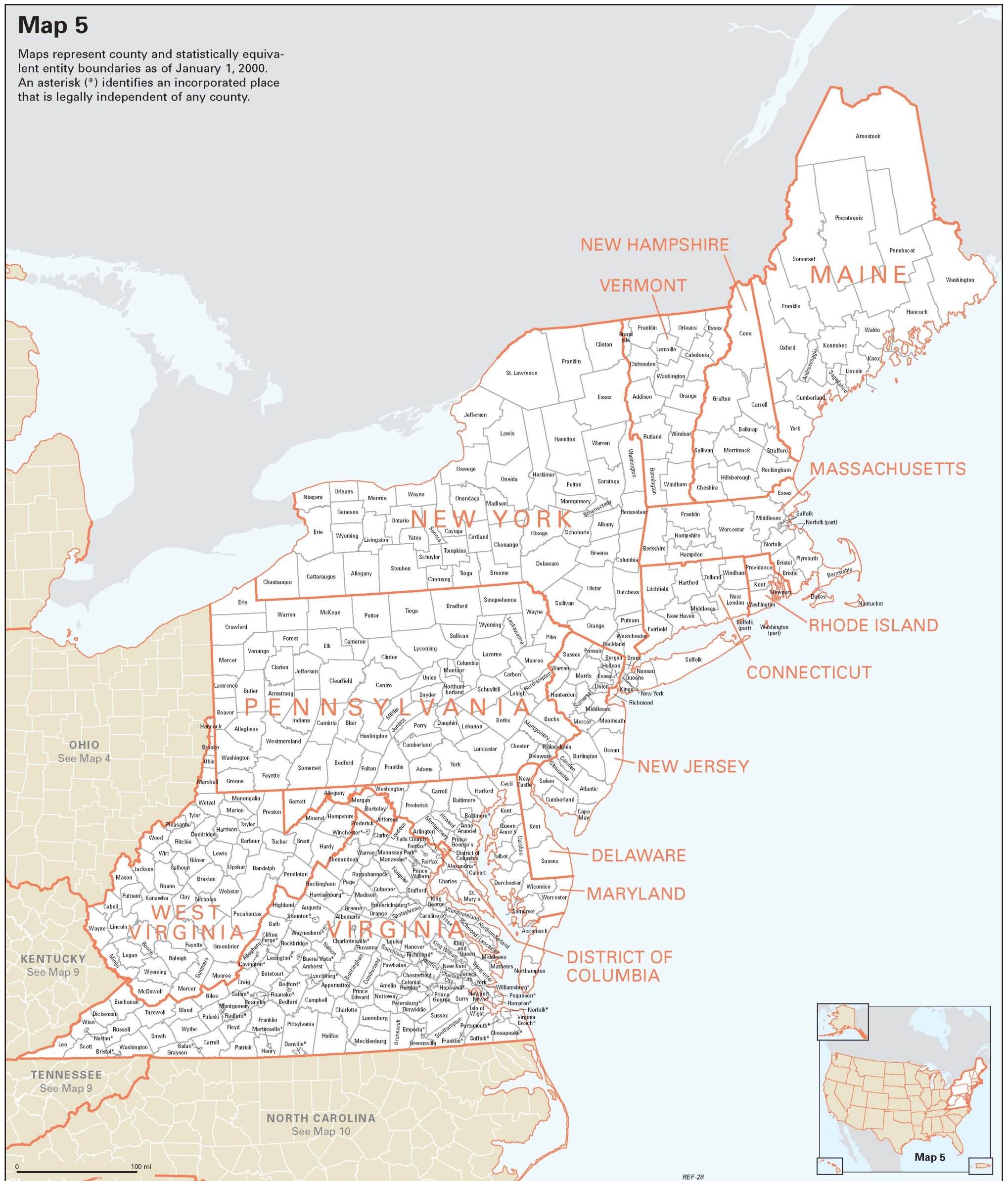

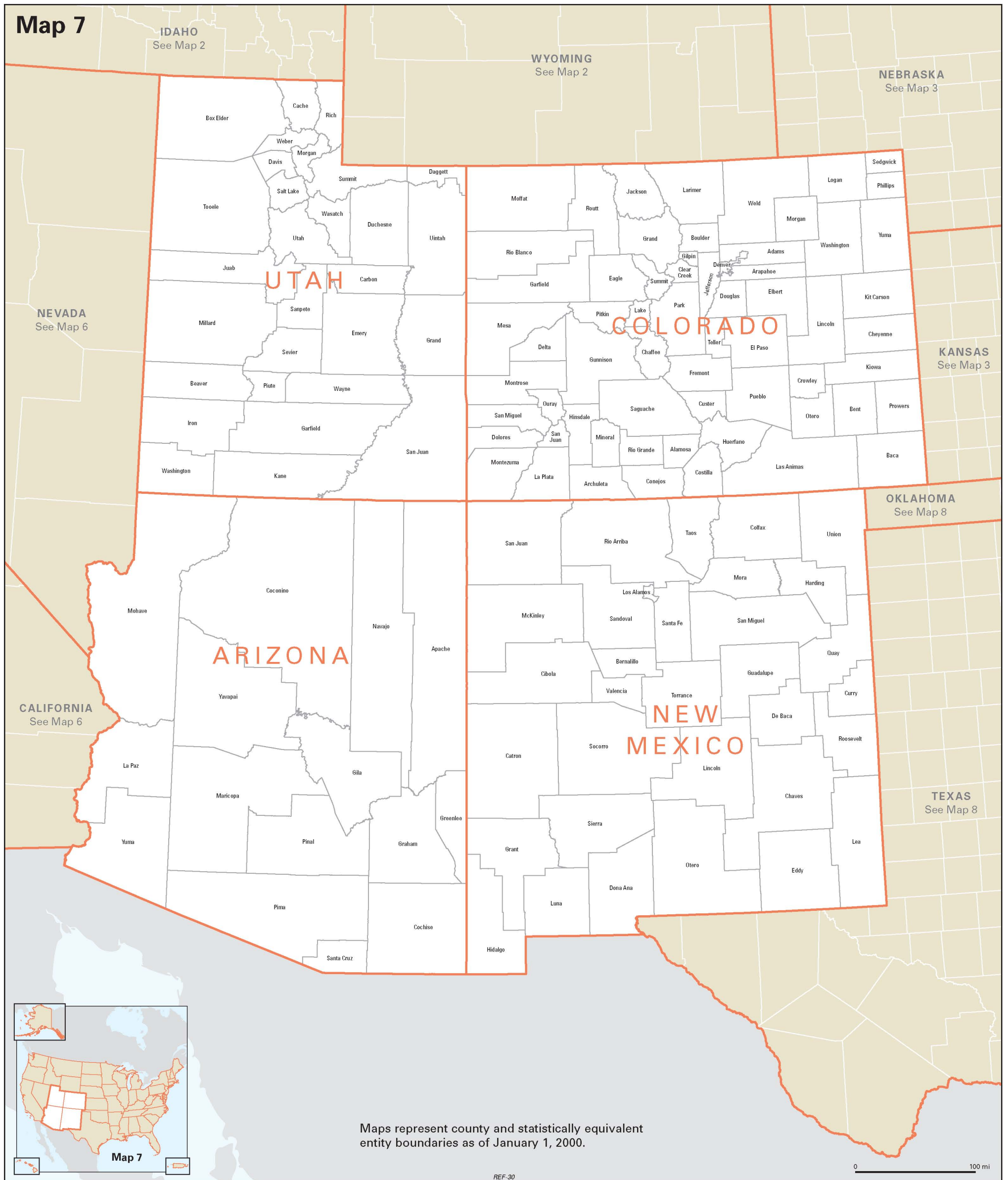

Maps represent county and statistically equivalent entity boundaries as of January 1, 2000. An asterisk (\*) identifies an incorporated place that is legally independent of any county.

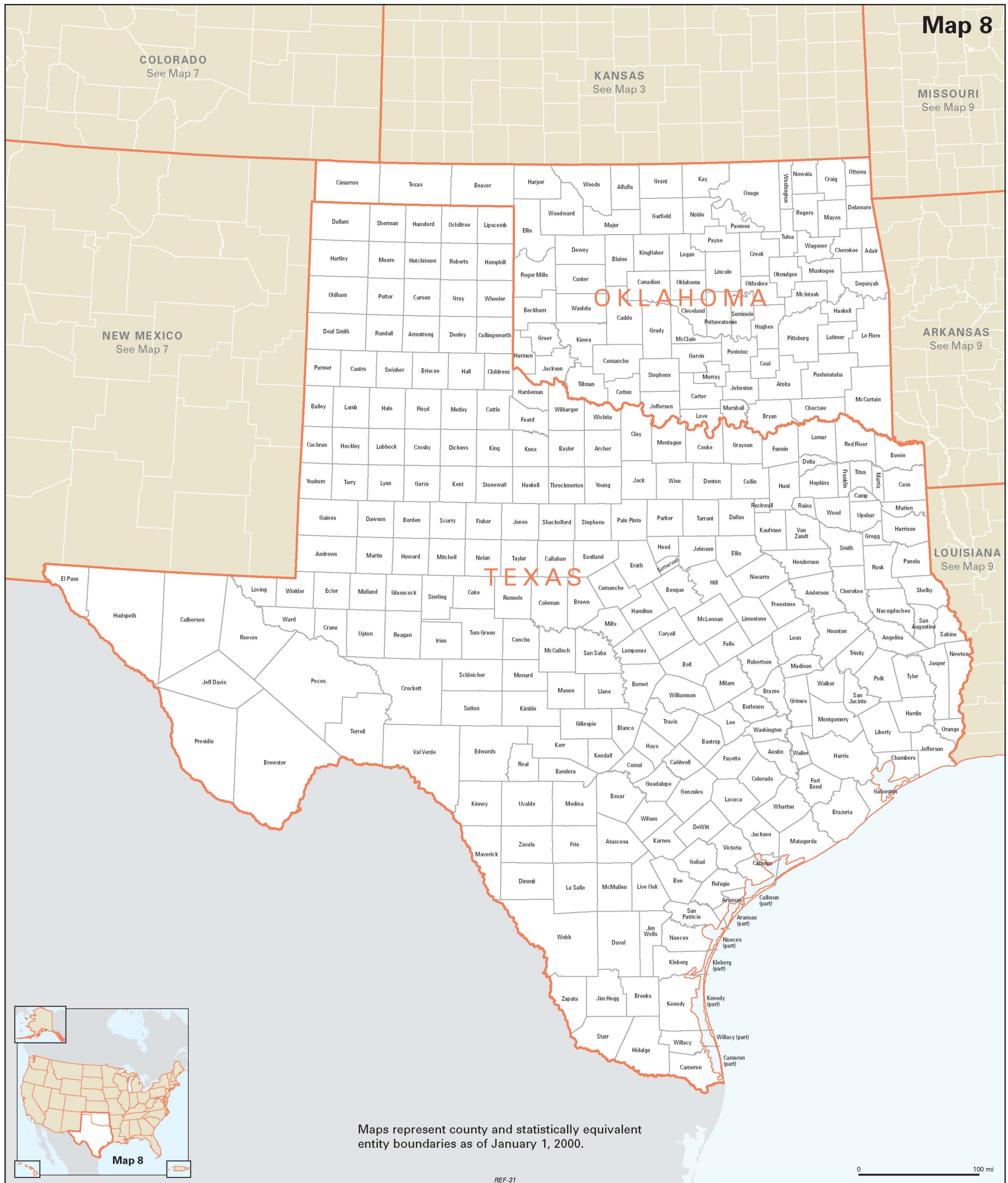




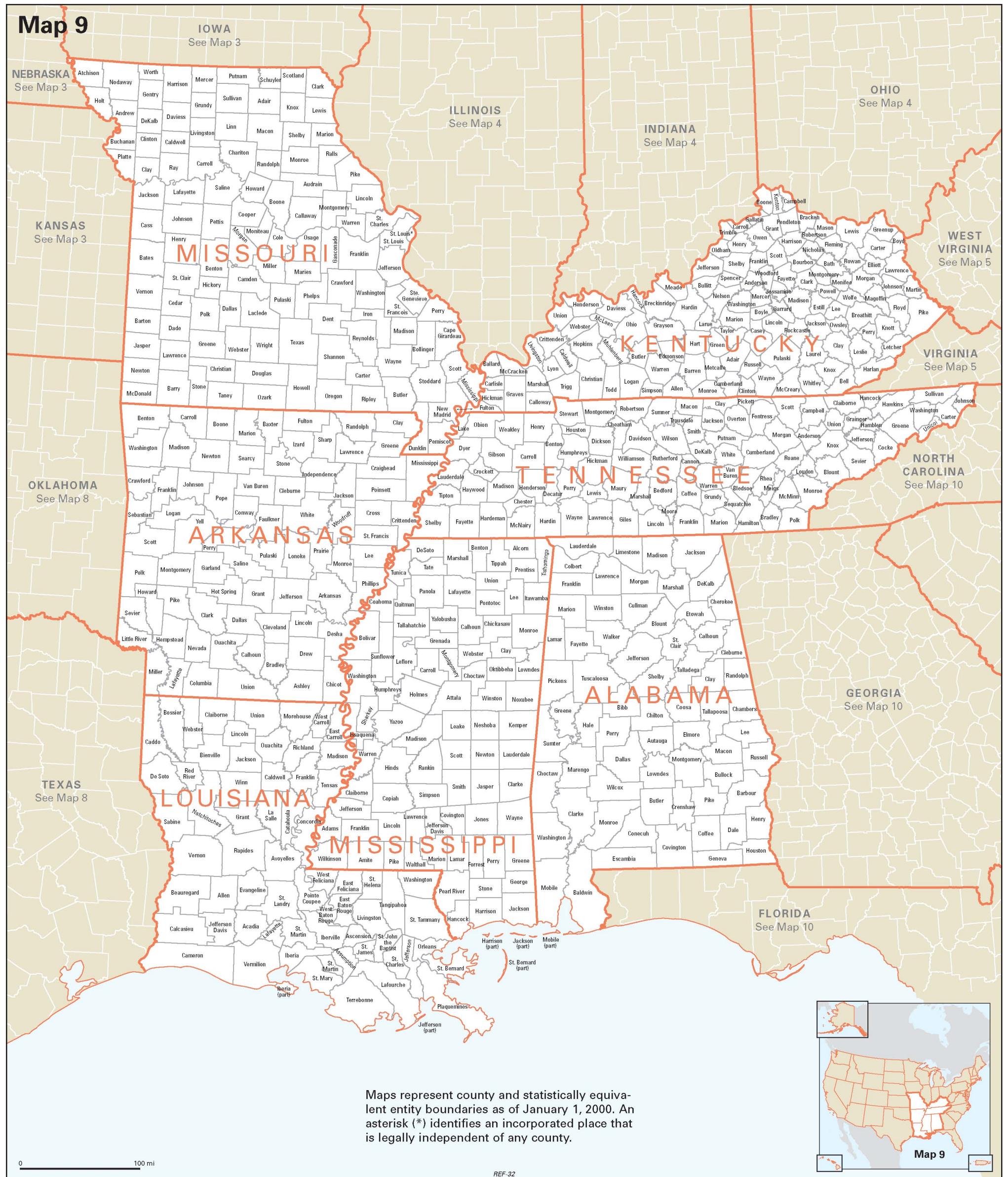
