PROJNAME refers to the project name. The naming convention for this would follow the same rules as for other types of files:

For Forest Highways, the first two or three characters are the state designation and the next two or three are the route number.

For Park and Wildlife Refuge Roads projects, the first four characters are the Park/Refuge four-character designation and the next two characters are the route designation.

The dash will help set off the file type designation and allow ready recognition of the contents of the files.

Additional information is permissible after the mandatory characters as required to more specifically identify the file and its purpose.
