Advantages to reporting through the Census Taker system

- Reduced time and expense to report

- Data saved to Census Bureau servers as you complete the form.
You can exit the electronic form and resume at a later time without losing your data
- Save a paper or electronic copy of your completed report
- Context-sensitive help to assist your reporting

System requirements

- A browser that supports 128-bit encryption. All major browsers since 1998
- A username and password issued by the U.S. Census Bureau located on your paper form below the address label

Security

- Data are encrypted at all times
- No cookies are used
- No plug-in or downloaded software is required
