Transportation and warehousing accounted for the highest incidence rate for days away from work, job transfer, or restriction, with 4.9 cases per 100 fulltime workers.

The total rate for cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction was 2.5 cases per 100 full-time workers.

The rate for cases with days away from work was 1.4 cases per 100 full-time workers, and the rate for cases with only job transfer, or restriction was 1.1 cases per 100 full-time workers.
