
Repetitive motion cases resulted in the longest absences from work.

Repetitive motion cases resulted in the longest absences from work. Falls to a lower level, with 14 days, and transportation accidents, with 10 days, had the next-longest median days away from work.

The median number of days away from work for transportation accidents was 10 in 2004, compared with 14 in 2003.
