



SABIT GROUP PROGRAM HOSPITAL ADMINISTRATION FOR CENTRAL ASIA, WESTERN EURASIA & THE CAUCASUS

JANUARY 19 – FEBRUARY 16, 2008

SCOPE AND MISSION

The SABIT Hospital Administration program is designed to train 18 mid- to senior-level healthcare executives from Central Asia (Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan), Western Eurasia (Moldova, Ukraine) and the Caucasus (Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia). These delegates, screened and selected by the U.S. Department of Commerce, represent industry leaders who are seeking information in order to improve their healthcare systems. This program will introduce participants to industry standards and trends in hospital administration and help them establish contacts with potential partners in the U.S. healthcare system.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

The Hospital Administration program's goal is to introduce modern healthcare management techniques to executives from Eurasia. This will be done primarily through meetings with leading U.S. healthcare organizations that will present the latest in health care innovations and best management practices. The delegates will gain a comprehensive understanding of hospital administration practices in the United States and will return home with the skills and knowledge necessary to make improvements within their own organizations and healthcare systems.

BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATION

This is a unique opportunity for U.S. companies to provide industry insight and training while showcasing their products and services to their Eurasian counterparts. By hosting this SABIT delegation, U.S. companies will build relationships with leaders of the health care sector in Eurasia. Through these valuable contacts, host companies can explore commercial opportunities, cooperation, and partnerships in the region.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The program will begin in January 2008 in Washington, DC with visits to relevant government agencies and associations in the metro area. During the remaining three weeks, the group will travel to relevant regions across the country to meet with leading U.S. hospitals, healthcare providers and industry experts.

HOST THIS DELEGATION

SABIT is currently looking for U.S. hosts to provide training sessions for up to a full day at their facilities. Training should emphasize some of the following topics that are of interest to the delegates, and represent some of the current challenges they face within their organizations:

- Hospital management
- Developments in technology and medical equipment
- Quality-of-care and performance improvement
- Personnel management and development
- In-patient and out-patient services
- Financial and budget management
- Health insurance
- HIV and TB prevention, testing, and care
- Public versus private healthcare facilities
- Medical associations
- Mobile clinics and telemedicine technology
- Emergency department and trauma center administration

COST OF PARTICIPATION

SABIT will cover the majority of program costs for all delegates, including round-trip airfare to the United States, all U.S. domestic air travel, housing, insurance, per diem for meals and incidentals, and interpreters to travel with the group. In turn, U.S. host companies and organizations are asked to provide industry expertise in the topics pertaining to this particular program.
