Dear Mr. McFarland:

The Bureau of Industry and Security, United States Department of Commerce ("BIS"), has reason to believe that McFarland Cascade of Tacoma, Washington ("McFarland") violated the Export Administration Regulations (the "Regulations"),¹ which are issued under the authority of the Export Administration Act of 1979 (the "Act"),² on 1136 occasions. Specifically, BIS charges that McFarland committed the following violations:

**Charges 1-1136 15 C.F.R. § 764.2(a) - Exporting Items Without the Required
Department of Commerce Licenses**

On 1136 occasions between on or about November 9, 1999, and February 19, 2004, McFarland engaged in conduct prohibited by the Regulations by exporting utility poles composed of unprocessed Western Red Cedar, items subject to the Regulations (ECCN³ 1C988), to Canada for

During that period, the President, through Executive Order 12924, which had been extended by successive Presidential Notices, the last of which was August 3, 2000 (3 C.F.R., 2000 Comp. 397 (2001)), continued the Regulations in effect under the International Emergency Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. §§ 1701 - 1706 (2000)) ("IEEPA"). On November 13, 2000, the Act was reauthorized by Pub. L. No. 106-508 (114 Stat. 2360 (2000)) and it remained in effect through August 20, 2001. Executive Order 13222 of August 17, 2001 (3 C.F.R., 2001 Comp., p. 783 (2002)), which has been extended by successive Presidential Notices, the most recent being that of August 6, 2004 (69 Fed. Reg. 48763 (August 10, 2004)), continues the Regulations in effect under IEEPA.

further processing without obtaining the Department of Commerce licenses required by Section 754.4(a) of the Regulations. The violations are further described in the schedule of violations which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. In so doing, McFarland committed 1136 violations of Section 764.2(a) of the Regulations.

Accordingly, McFarland is hereby notified that an administrative proceeding is instituted against it pursuant to Part 766 of the Regulations for the purpose of obtaining an order imposing administrative sanctions, including any or all of the following:

The maximum civil penalty allowed by law of \$11,000 per violation;⁴

Denial of export privileges; and/or

Exclusion from practice before BIS.

If McFarland fails to answer the charges contained in this letter within 30 days after being served with notice of issuance of this letter, that failure will be treated as a default. *See* 15 C.F.R. §§ 766.6 and 766.7. If McFarland defaults, the Administrative Law Judge may find the charges alleged in this letter are true without a hearing or further notice to McFarland. *See id.* The Under Secretary for Industry and Security may then impose up to the maximum penalty on the charges in this letter. *See id.*

McFarland is further notified that it is entitled to an agency hearing on the record if McFarland files a written demand for one with its answer. *See* 15 C.F.R. § 766.6. McFarland is also entitled to be represented by counsel or other authorized representative who has power of attorney to represent it. *See* 15 C.F.R. §§ 766.3(a) and 766.4.

The Regulations provide for settlement without a hearing. *See* 15 C.F.R. § 766.18. Should McFarland have a proposal to settle this case, its representative should transmit it to the attorney representing BIS named below.

The U.S. Coast Guard is providing administrative law judge services in connection with the matters set forth in this letter. Accordingly, McFarland's answer must be filed in accordance with the instructions set forth in Section 766.5(a) of the Regulations with:



SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") is made by and between McFarland Cascade Pole & Lumber Company ("McFarland"), and the Bureau of Industry and Security, U.S. Department of Commerce ("BIS") (collectively referred to as "Parties"), pursuant to Section 766.18(b) of the Export Administration Regulations (currently codified at 15 C.F.R. Parts 730-774 (2005)) ("Regulations"),¹ issued pursuant to the Export Administration Act of 1979, as amended (50 U.S.C. app. §§ 2401-2420 (2000)) ("Act"),²

During that period, the President, through Executive Order 12924, which had been extended by successive Presidential Notices, the last of which was August 3, 2000 (3 C.F.R., 2000 Comp. 397 (2001)), continued the Regulations in effect under the International Emergency Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. §§ 1701 - 1706 (2000)) ("IEEPA"). On November 13, 2000, the Act was reauthorized and it remained in effect through August 20, 2001. Since August 21, 2001, the Act has been in lapse and the President, through Executive Order 13222 of August 17, 2001 (3 C.F.R., 2001 Comp. 783 (2002)), as extended by the Notice of August 2, 2005 (70 *Fed. Reg.* 45273, August 5, 2005), has continued the Regulations in effect under the IEEPA.

WHEREAS, BIS has initiated an administrative proceeding against McFarland, pursuant to the Act and the Regulations;

WHEREAS, BIS has issued a charging letter to McFarland that alleged that McFarland committed 1136 violations of the Regulations, specifically:

1. *1136 Violations of 15 C.F.R. § 764.2(a) - Exporting Items Without the Required Department of Commerce Licenses:* On 1136 occasions between on or about November 9, 1999, and February 19, 2004, McFarland engaged in conduct prohibited by the Regulations by exporting utility poles composed of unprocessed western red cedar harvested from Federal or State lands, items subject to the Regulations (ECCN³ 1C988), to Canada for further processing without obtaining the Department of Commerce licenses required by Section 754.4(a) of the Regulations.

WHEREAS, McFarland has reviewed the charging letter and is aware of the allegations made against it and the administrative sanctions which could be imposed against it if the allegations are found to be true;

WHEREAS, McFarland fully understands the terms of this Agreement and the Order ("Order") that the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Export Enforcement will issue if she approves this Agreement as the final resolution of this matter;

WHEREAS, McFarland enters into this Agreement voluntarily and with full knowledge of its rights;

WHEREAS, McFarland states that no promises or representations have been made to it other than the agreements and considerations herein expressed;

WHEREAS, McFarland does not admit the allegations contained in the charging letter;

WHEREAS, McFarland wishes to settle and dispose of all matters alleged in the charging letter by entering into this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, McFarland agrees to be bound by the Order, if entered;

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. BIS has jurisdiction over McFarland, under the Regulations, in connection with the matters alleged in the charging letter.

2. The following sanction shall be imposed against McFarland in complete settlement of the violations of the Regulations set forth in the charging letter:

1. McFarland shall be assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$454,000, which shall be paid to the U.S. Department of Commerce within 30 days from the date of entry of the Order. Payment shall be made in the manner specified in the attached instructions.

2. The timely payment of the civil penalty agreed to in paragraph 2.a. is hereby made a condition to the granting, restoration, or continuing validity of any export license, License Exception, permission, or privilege granted, or to be granted, to McFarland. Failure to make timely payment of the civil penalty set forth above may result in the denial of all of McFarland's export privileges for a period of one year from the date of imposition of the penalty.

3. Subject to the approval of this Agreement pursuant to paragraph 8 hereof, McFarland hereby waives all rights to further procedural steps in this matter (except with respect to any alleged violations of this Agreement or the Order, if entered), including, without limitation, any right to: (a) an administrative hearing regarding the allegations in the charging letter; (b) request

a refund of any civil penalty paid pursuant to this Agreement and the Order, if entered; (c) request any relief from the Order, if entered, including without limitation relief from the terms of a denial order under 15 C.F.R. § 764.3(a)(2); and (d) seek judicial review or otherwise contest the validity of this Agreement or the Order, if entered.

4. Upon entry of the Order and timely payment of the \$454,000 civil penalty, BIS will not initiate any further administrative proceeding against McFarland in connection with any violation of the Act or the Regulations arising out of the transactions identified in the charging letter.

5. BIS will make the charging letter, this Agreement, and the Order, if entered, available to the public and record of the case as described in Section 766.22 of the Regulations.

6. This Agreement is for settlement purposes only. Therefore, if this Agreement is not accepted and the Order is not issued by the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Export Enforcement pursuant to Section 766.18(b) of the Regulations, no Party may use this Agreement in any administrative or judicial proceeding and the Parties shall not be bound by the terms contained in this Agreement in any subsequent administrative or judicial proceeding.


7. No agreement, understanding, representation or interpretation not contained in this Agreement may be used to vary or otherwise affect the terms of this Agreement or the Order, if entered, nor shall this Agreement serve to bind, constrain, or otherwise limit any action by any other agency or department of the U.S. Government with respect to the facts and circumstances addressed herein.

8. This Agreement shall become binding on BIS only if the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Export Enforcement approves it by entering the Order, which will have the same force and effect as a decision and order issued after a full administrative hearing on the record.

9. Each signatory affirms that he has authority to enter into this Settlement Agreement and to bind his respective party to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

ORDER RELATING TO MCFARLAND CASCADE POLE & LUMBER COMPANY

The Bureau of Industry and Security, U.S. Department of Commerce (“BIS”) having initiated an administrative proceeding against McFarland Cascade Pole & Lumber Company (“McFarland”), pursuant to Section 766.3 of the Export Administration Regulations (currently codified at 15 C.F.R. Parts 730-774 (2005)) (“Regulations”),¹ and Section 13(c) of the Export Administration Act of 1979, as amended (50 U.S.C. app. §§ 2401-2420 (2000)) (“Act”),² by

Since August 21, 2001, the Act has been in lapse and the President, through Executive Order 13222 of August 17, 2001 (3 C.F.R., 2001 Comp. 783 (2002)), as extended by the Notice of August 2, 2005 (70 *Fed. Reg.* 45273, August 5, 2005), has continued the Regulations in effect under the IEEPA.

issuing a charging letter to McFarland that alleged that McFarland committed 1136 violations of the Regulations. Specifically, the charges are:

1. *1136 Violations of 15 C.F.R. § 764.2(a) - Exporting Items Without the Required Department of Commerce Licenses:* On 1136 occasions between on or about November 9, 1999, and February 19, 2004, McFarland engaged in conduct prohibited by the Regulations by exporting utility poles composed of unprocessed western red cedar harvested from Federal or State lands, items subject to the Regulations (ECCN³ 1C988), to Canada for further processing without obtaining the Department of Commerce licenses required by Section 754.4(a) of the Regulations.

WHEREAS, BIS and McFarland have entered into a Settlement Agreement pursuant to Section 766.18(b) of the Regulations whereby they agreed to settle this matter in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, I have approved of the terms of such Settlement Agreement;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

FIRST, that a civil penalty of \$454,000 is assessed against McFarland, which shall be paid to the U.S. Department of Commerce within 30 days from the date of entry of the Order. Payment shall be made in the manner specified in the attached instructions.


SECOND, that, pursuant to the Debt Collection Act of 1982, as amended (31 U.S.C. §§ 3701-3720E (2000)), the civil penalty owed under this Order accrues interest as more fully described in the attached Notice, and, if payment is not made by the due date specified herein, McFarland will be assessed, in addition to the full amount of the civil penalty and interest, a penalty charge and an administrative charge, as more fully described in the attached Notice.

THIRD, that the timely payment of the civil penalty set forth above is hereby made a condition to the granting, restoration, or continuing validity of any export license, license exception, permission, or privilege granted, or to be granted, to McFarland. Accordingly, if McFarland should fail to pay the civil penalty in a timely manner, the undersigned may enter an Order denying all of McFarland's export privileges for a period of one year from the date of entry of this Order.

FOURTH, that a copy of this Order shall be delivered to the Honorable Peter A. Fitzpatrick, United States Coast Guard, Norfolk Federal Office Building, 200 Granby Street, Room 602, Norfolk, Virginia 23510-18888; and the United States Coast Guard ALJ Docketing Center, 40 Gay Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202-4022, notifying them that this case is withdrawn from adjudication, as provided by Section 766.18 of the Regulations.

FIFTH, that the charging letter, the Settlement Agreement, this Order, and the record of this case as defined in Section 766.20 of the Regulations shall be made available to the public.

This Order, which constitutes the final agency action in this matter, is effective immediately.
