

Portland-Vancouver-Beaverton, OR-WA

- In the first half of 2007, the Portland-Vancouver-Beaverton metropolitan area was the 14th largest export market in the U.S., with sales totaling \$7.6 billion.
- Canada was the leading export destination for Portland's exports of goods in the first half of 2007. Other leading destinations were Japan and China.
- In the first half of 2007, Portland benefited from existing free trade agreements, exporting \$1.7 billion to Canada and Mexico.
- Twenty-two percent of Portland's merchandise exports go to NAFTA countries.
- Computer and electronic products was the top Portland export category for the first half of 2007, accounting for \$2.8 billion, or 37 percent, of exported goods.
- Other top exports were crop production (\$1.2 billion, 16 percent); machinery, except electrical (\$879 million, 12 percent); and transportation equipment (\$780 million, 10 percent).
