Discussion Items

1. Voting on Architecture CRs

 Architecture CR 4789 (SCR tbd) – Synopsis: Implement SAFER-CVIEW interface for Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) information.
 Recommended for approval – 16 approve, 0 abstain, 35 non-voters.

2. Architecture CRs for Voting at the next meeting

None.

3. Prioritization of CVISN Architecture/SAFER CRs

Volpe is incorporating states' input on priorities into the FY 2008 SAFER release plan.

4. FMCSA Technical Support: Report on trouble tickets and defects

Bugs in SAFER 7.3 release were discussed. Volpe said that states should use the old versions of the T20028, T0029, and T0031 transactions. States requested Volpe to disseminate information on SAFER problems via email from FMCSA Technical Support. States also requested Volpe to summarize the current problems and work-around for states in an email.

5. Volpe/PRISM: Report on PRISM CRs relevant to CVISN stakeholders

None this month. Jodee Alm asked for input on what barcode readers work for multiple applications.

6. Open SAFER CRs

Volpe reported on one revised and three new SAFER CRs.

SAFER CR 1842 "Develop edits to flag the change of the IRP_Status_Code" was rewritten to state that Volpe will generate a report of vehicle records that are outside of the expiration date grace period. There was discussion of how the grace period will be determined. Volpe will update the CR to include a table with state-specific grace periods based on the table on the IRP, Inc. website

(http://www.irponline.org/InfoExchange/JurisdictionInformation/Registration/default.htm

). States should check the information and let Volpe know what to use. The default will be the grace period defined in the table plus 30 days.

SAFER CR 2011 requests an indicator if a carrier exceeds the threshold in one or more BASIC measurements. Volpe will send more information on this request to the states.

8. Developers' Call

Jingfei reported that there is no firm answer yet on the impact of the ISO country code change on SAFER-CVIEW.

9. Other Items

Jingfei verified that the spreadsheet showing the status and frequency of states' uploads to SAFER will be made available to the states on a quarterly basis. Volpe will post the spreadsheet to the General Documents page of the CVISN ACCB Collaboration site.
