All previous requirements of the original RFO and SFI, dated March 12, 2004, including amended Sections 9 & 13 dated March 25, 2004, will remain in effect except as noted in this letter and the Amended Sections of this RFO and SFI annotated in **bold red**.

Please note the following amended significant items:

- 1. <u>Basis for Determining Applicable Distance/Mileage</u>: Per Section 7 freight shipments identified herein and handled pursuant to the STOS will be based on mileage provided by ALK Technologies, Inc., 5 digit Zip Code, Version 18 (coincides with PC*Miler 18). ALK Technologies, Inc., 5 digit Zip, Version 18
- 2. <u>Identification of Non-Alternating Standing Route Orders (SRO) Traffic for the Western Distribution Center French Camp, CA</u>: Per Section 10 the Non-Alternating SRO for the Western Distribution Center (WDC) French Camp, CA Freight-all- Kinds (FAK) has been removed from the this Request for Offer. The Special Filing Instructions for the WDC FAK will be relocated in Section 9 of the 2004-2005 NIB/NISH & WDC RFO and will be posted approximately September 1, 2004.
- 3. <u>Identification of Alternating Standing Route Order (SRO) Traffic for the Submission of Alternating SRO Rate Offers:</u> Per Section 15 rates are being requested for the SRO code FPITI for Terminal Island, CA that was omitted in the RFO dated March 12, 2004;
- 4. <u>Mandatory E-mail Address</u>: Per Section 16 booking office e-mails by route level have become mandatory for the purpose of online booking within TMSS;
