## Who Needs Hazmat training?

Any hazmat employee – that is, any one regulated under the HMR – must receive

hazardous materials training.

You are regulated by the HMR if your work or your employees' work directly affects the safety of hazardous materials transportation.

Furthermore, any hazmat employee requires initial hazmat training, as well as recurrent training every three years.

- Shipping Papers
- Marking and Labeling
- Placarding
- Packaging
- Carrier Requirements for all four modes
- End-of-module tests and printable test records
