JWOD TAKES LEAD TO “GREEN” THE JANITORIAL BUSINESS WITH NEW TRAINING COURSE

Attention Federal Customers Involved in the Management of JWOD or Other Janitorial Contracts:

This year, NISH is offering a new, 2-day JWOD Training Course called “Greening the Janitorial Business” on June 14–15 in San Francisco, CA, and on September 20–21 in Washington, DC. This course will introduce specific policies, practices, and products to aid in making your janitorial operations both safer for your employees and environmentally preferable. In addition to learning the environmental hazards associated with janitorial chemicals and how to use and manage them in compliance with OSHA/EPA regulations, you’ll also gain an understanding of how to market the “green concept” to building managers and other potential customers.

“Greening the Janitorial Business” will provide:

- An overview of green cleaning principles and cleaning concepts. How to transition to a green cleaning program. How to involve and train employees in green cleaning.
- A list of environmentally preferable chemical cleaning

products including what are the attributes of concern for green cleaning chemicals, relying particularly on third party standards in development by Green Seal and EPA Region 9’s Janitorial Pollution Prevention Project.

- A list of environmentally preferable janitorial supplies, paper towels, bathroom tissue, and plastic trash bags that comply with or exceed the Comprehensive Procurement Guidelines
- A model cleaning stewardship plan consistent with ASTM Standard E-1971, “A Standard Guide on Stewardship for Cleaning Commercial and Institutional Buildings”
