THERMAL IMAGE CAMERAS

After several years of development, Raytheon Corporation has introduced two new sensors for use in camera systems made by the independent manufacturers of Raytheon's OEM group.

IVI

The newest infrared sensor, being introduced in early 2001, is the Amorphous Silicon Bolometer. This infrared sensor is made from silicon wafers — like video cameras and computer chips. Silicon sensor wafers can be made thousands at a time for a few dollars per wafer. In the foreseeable future, Thermal Image Cameras will be as common and inexpensive as a quality video camera is today.

The second new development is a digital "Thermal Camera" that is now available to the independent manufacturers of the Raytheon OEM group. Engineers have incorporated a digital zoom feature in this model that will allow a 2:1 zoom to be done with no change to the lenses. The 2:1 zoom is accomplished with the simple flick of a switch. Thermal image cameras use lenses made from Germanium or Zinc-Selinide because glass and most plastics will not allow heat (infrared energy) to pass through them. Germanium and Zinc-Selinide are man-made materials and very expensive to manufacture.

Since "Thermal Camera" sees heat not light, a very small portion of a person can be seen through foliage and is immediately recognized as a hot spot. A warm bodied person in

a cold climate or a person in water is easily seen as a hot spot from a distance. The "Thermal Camera" sees through smoke, tear gas, rain, sleet, snow, hail, smog, and blowing dust – usually as if the obscurant was not even there. The "Thermal Camera" will always see better and further than your naked eye or video camera.
