CLAIM SUMMARIES

To assist claimants and families in understanding their potential Fund award, the Special Master has set forth some real-life examples of claims paid by the Fund. Just by way of example, the beneficiaries of:

A married military officer, age 26 with no dependents and a base compensation of \$44,000, received a net award of \$1,841,128 after offsets of \$168,489.

A married broker, age 34 with one dependent and a base compensation of \$82,000, received an award of \$2,021,046 after \$466,000 in collateral offsets.

A single trader, age 34 with no dependents and a base salary of \$100,000, received an award of \$1,356,552 after collateral offsets of \$150,000.

A married business official, age 38 with one dependent and a base compensation of \$65,000, received an award of \$984,834 after collateral offsets of \$587,598.

A single business official, age 42 with no dependents and base compensation of \$120,000, received a net award of \$953,862 after collateral offsets of \$300,000.

A single professional, age 43 with no dependents and a base salary of \$94,000, received an award of \$1,164,408 after collateral offsets of \$50,000.

A married laborer, age 47 with 3 dependents and a base compensation of \$58,000, received an award of \$1,036,556 after collateral offsets of \$298,694.

A married civilian working at the Pentagon, age 54 with no dependents and a base compensation of \$116,000, received an award of \$685,573 after collateral offsets of \$508,850.

A single civilian employee working on building maintenance and recycling, age 24 and base compensation of \$32,000, received a net award of \$1.2 million (including value for caring for seriously ill parent) after collateral offsets.

A married project manager, age 36 with one dependent and a base salary of \$231,000, received a net award of \$3,481,491 after \$939,680 in collateral offsets.
