- 1) **Oxygen – Acetylene Cutting Torches**
  - Keep your torch in good condition and free of oil and grease
  - Repair damaged hoses immediately with correct fittings and crimping tools
  - Do not leave your torch unattended
  
- 2) **Compressed Gases**
  - Never transport oxygen or acetylene bottles laying on their side
  - Firmly secure bottles in an upright position with protective cap in place
  - Protect bottles and valves from being struck by foreign objects
  
- 2) **Eye Protection**
  - Face shields or goggles must be worn when operating a grinder
  - Safety glasses should be worn in all working areas
  - Welding shields must be kept clean and free of defects
