The U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) is pleased to submit the annual progress report entitled, *Report to Congress on the Fiscal Year (FY) 2007 Competitive Sourcing Efforts*. This report is provided in response to Government-wide reporting requirements established in Section 647(b) of Division F of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, FY 2004 (Public Law 108-199) and supplementary guidance contained in the Office of Management and Budget's (OMB) Memorandum M-08-02 dated October 31, 2007.

The Department did not complete or initiate any competitions during 2007. Enclosure 1 includes up-to-date savings and performance information about competitions completed during 2003 through 2006. Enclosure 2 discusses future competition plans and DOT's workforce planning and human capital initiative.
