Introduction

The *U.S. International Air Passenger and Freight Statistics* report has been developed to provide the public with additional access to international aviation data. The report is restricted to nonstop commercial traffic traveling between international points and U.S. airports. Global air travel systems are comprised of complex, ever-changing networks and alliances. The majority of international passengers to and from the U.S. make at least one connection before reaching their final destination. This report represents a limited aspect of international travel - nonstop flows into and out of the U.S. Cities that serve as an international gateway will have high numbers in this report, but users should bear in mind that some portion of this traffic continued on a connecting flight to their final destination. Conversely, U.S. carriers serve some international points only through an international connection; therefore it might look as if no U.S. carrier serves a certain international point when in fact U.S. carrier traffic is first flowing through a connecting city. Figures for U.S. nonstop market share do not necessarily correlate to the total service provided to that point by U.S. carriers.

The widespread use of code-share agreements also influences this data. Under a code-share agreement, it is common for a passenger to fly on an aircraft owned and operated by a different airline than the one from which they bought their ticket. The data in this report represents the air carrier that operated the passenger or cargo flight reported. In some cases, such as U.S. to China, regulatory impediments make it difficult for U.S. domestic carriers to operate adequate service using their own equipment. U.S. carriers compensate by marketing and selling tickets under their own code to those destinations, and then arranging for a foreign code-share partner to actually transport the passengers. Therefore low U.S. market share in certain restricted markets is not indicative of the true proportion of passengers purchasing U.S. carrier tickets, but rather represents the type of carrier that transported the passengers reported. Code-sharing and network-flow data issues also apply to cargo shipments.

The data in this report is presented in a top-down format. Table 1 provides gross summaries of U.S.-international passengers, capacity, and freight. The same data is then broken down by world area, and country in Tables 2 through 5. Scheduled passenger data for the largest domestic gateway cities, the largest foreign gateway cities, and the largest U.S.-international airport-pairs can be found in Tables 6, 7, and 8. All data is derived from the T-100 Segment reports submitted to the Department by U.S. and foreign carriers.

The T-100 program was instituted by the Department of Transportation effective January 1, 1990. It covers traffic reports of foreign airlines operating to the United States and traffic reports of the domestic and international operations of U.S. airlines. The airlines submit these reports monthly to the Department's Office of Airline Information (OAI) of the Bureau of Transportation Statistics. The rules governing disclosure of the International T-100 data require that the data be kept confidential for a period of six months beyond the reporting date.

Users of this report should take the following points into consideration:

- The T-100 segment data includes all traffic arriving at U.S. airports and departing from U.S. airports on nonstop commercial international flights.
- Air carriers that operate aircraft with 60 seats or less are not required to file T-100 data. Therefore passenger volume in particular markets—particularly the Caribbean and certain Canadian markets – is understated in this report due to the large amount of service provided by small aircraft.
- T-100 data represents only nonstop service. The absence of U.S. nonstop service, or a low U.S. flag market share, does not necessarily correlate to the amount of service provided to that point by

U.S. carriers. Many international destinations are served by U.S. carriers via connecting points. Those not heavily served on a nonstop basis are underrepresented in this report.

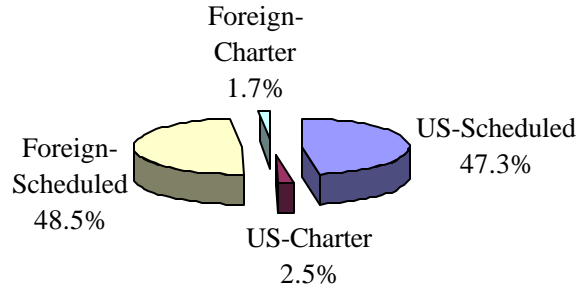
- Conversely, traffic on U.S.-international routes that serve as connecting gateways will exceed the number of true Origin & Destination passengers on the route because of the high percentage of traffic connecting through the gateway.
- Code-share relationships may cause U.S. carriers to seem under-represented in certain restrictive markets. This data is reported according to the operating carrier. In extensive code-share relationships (particularly to certain Asian countries) U.S. airlines sell a large number of tickets to passengers and then provide transport through the foreign code-share partner.
- Cargo carriers also employ the use of networks and code-share arrangements; therefore cargo data is susceptible to the same reporting shortcomings in this report as passenger data.
- Freight tons do not include mail.
- The T100 dataset is dynamic and subject to edits and updates. The data in this report represent a snapshot of the T100 segment on the day the report tables are generated. This report will contain most recent data for the current month and previous 35 months.

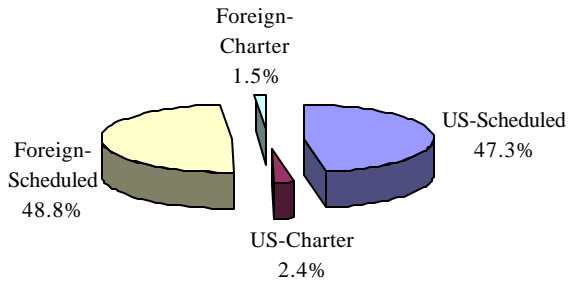
Summary for the Month of- and Year Ended- December 2001

U.S. and foreign air carriers transported 130.6 million passengers between the United States and the rest of the world for the year-ended December 2001. This represents a traffic decrease of 9.2% over the previous year. U.S. flag market share increased from 48.9% to 49.8%.

U.S.-international Passengers YE December 2001



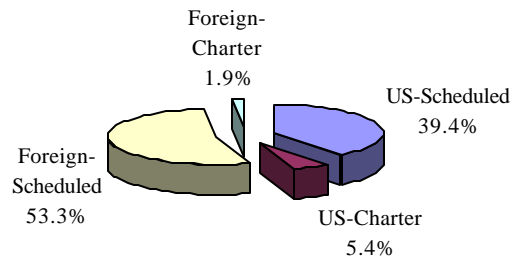
U.S.-international Seats YE December 2001



Available seats into and out of the United States decreased by 5.4% to 188.2 million for the year-ended December 2001 compared to the previous year. There were 1.2 million flights into and out of the U.S. during the same period. U.S. flag carriers held 49.7% of seat market share and performed 58.7% of departures.

U.S. and foreign airlines hauled 7.8 million freight tons to and from the United States during the year-ended December 2001, a 7.0% decrease from the previous year. U.S. flag share increased from 42.4% to 44.9%.

Passenger Traffic

Air passenger traffic between the U.S. and the rest of the world in December 2001 decreased 18.0% from December 2000, to 9,113,633 passengers. U.S. airlines carried 50.5% of passengers traveling to or from international destinations. Charter passengers accounted for 3.4% of international travel.

For the year-ended December 2001, U.S.-world traffic was down 9.2% from the previous year, to 130,590,350 passengers. U.S. airlines carried 49.8% of passengers, compared to 48.9% the previous year. Charter passengers accounted for 4.2% of international travel.

World Area Trends

Africa experienced the smallest decline in nonstop passenger growth to and from the U.S. for the year-ended December 2001. Africa passenger traffic contracted by 30 thousand passengers between the year-ended December 2001 and 2000, the smallest absolute regional decrease. All nine regions recorded negative annual nonstop passenger growth between the two periods. U.S.-to-Europe traffic contracted by 5.8 million passengers.

Nearly 46.0 million passengers flew between the U.S. and Europe for the year-ended December 2001, making it the largest U.S.-international regional gateway. Europe is followed by the Far East at 20.7 million passengers and Central America at 19.9 million.

Country Trends

The top five U.S.-international country passenger gateways for the year-ended December 2001 were Canada, the United Kingdom, Mexico, Japan, and Germany. No countries in the top 25 country markets posted positive passenger growth rates for the year-ended December 2001 vs. 2000. Twelve countries out of the top 25 posted loss rates greater than 10%. U.S. flag share was down in eight of the 25 country markets, remained unchanged in seven, and increased in ten countries.

Gateway Trends

The top domestic scheduled passenger gateway airports for the year-ended December 2001 were New York City-JFK, Los Angeles-LAX, Miami, Chicago-ORD, and Newark. Load factors were 70% or higher in 18 out of the top 40 domestic gateway airports. Load factors were below 60% in three of the top 40 – San Juan, New York-LGA, and San Antonio. 31 of 40 domestic gateways posted traffic losses compared to the year-ended December 2000.

The top foreign scheduled passenger gateways for the year-ended December 2001 were London-Heathrow, Tokyo, Toronto, Paris-Charles de Gaulle and Frankfurt. No international gateways had load factors of 80% or more for the annual period. Montreal and Toronto had the lowest load factors, both with 58%. Thirty-four of the top 40 foreign gateways reported traffic losses compared to the year-ended December 2000.

The top U.S.-international gateway segments were 1) New York-JFK to London-Heathrow; 2) Honolulu to Narita; 3) Los Angeles to Narita; 4) Los Angeles to London-Heathrow; and 5) Chicago-O'Hare to London-Heathrow.

Departures and Seat Capacity

Departures between the U.S. and the rest of the world for the month of December 2001 decreased 12.0% compared to December 2000. Available seats decreased by 17.4% over the same period. U.S. airlines provided 50.3% of international seats and 58.2% of departures. Charter service accounted for 3.3% of international seats and 4.1% of international departures.

For the year-ended December 2001, U.S.- world seats were down 5.4% over the previous year, to 188.2 million. Departures contracted by 0.6%. U.S. airlines provided 49.7% of seats, compared to 49.1% the previous year.

World Area Trends

Canada/Greenland experienced the smallest relative decrease in seats to and from the U.S. for the year-ended December 2001. Africa-to-U.S. capacity contracted 60 thousand seats between the year-ended December 2001 and 2000, the smallest absolute regional decrease. All nine regions recorded an annual seat capacity decrease between the two periods.

Over 61.7 million seats were available between the U.S. and Europe for the year-ended December 2001, making it the largest U.S.-international regional gateway from a capacity standpoint. Europe is followed by Central America with 29.2 million, the Far East with 29.0 million, and Canada/Greenland with 28.1 million seats.

Country Trends

The top five U.S.-international country gateways for seat capacity in the year-ended December 2001 were Canada, the United Kingdom, Mexico, Japan, and Germany. Only Hong Kong and Columbia posted positive seat capacity growth rates for year-ended December 2001 vs. 2000. Twenty-two countries posted negative rates. U.S. flag share was down in eight of the 25 country markets, remained unchanged in six, and increased in eleven.

Freight Traffic

Airfreight between the U.S. and the rest of the world in December 2001 decreased 10.3% from December 2000, to 647,187 tons. U.S. airlines carried 45.8% of freight to and from international destinations. Charter service accounted for 10.1% of international freight traffic.

For the year-ended December 2001, U.S.-world airfreight was down 7.0% over the previous year, to 7.8 million tons. U.S. airlines carried 44.9% of freight, compared to 42.4% the previous year.

World Area Trends

Canada/Greenland experienced the greatest relative increase in nonstop freight shipments to and from the U.S. for the year-ended December 2001. Canada/Greenland-to-U.S. freight traffic increased by 95,436 tons between the year-ended December 2001 and 2000, the largest absolute regional increase. Seven of nine regions recorded a loss of freight traffic between the two periods. Five regions had relative declines in excess of 10.0%, Central America (-10.16), the Far East (-12.74), Africa (-15.76), Australasia/Oceania (-18.58), and the Middle East (-19.57).

3.0 million tons of freight were transported between the U.S. and Europe for the year-ended December 2001, making Europe the largest U.S. international regional freight gateway. Europe is followed by the Far East with 2.6 million tons of freight.

Country Trends

The top five U.S.-international country gateways for freight in the year-ended December 2001 were Japan, the United Kingdom, South Korea, Germany, and Taiwan. Nine of the top 25 country markets posted positive freight growth rates for the year-ended December 2001 vs. 2000. South Korea, the Panama Republic, Switzerland, Spain, Japan, and Argentina reported losses of 10% or more. U.S. flag share was down in seven of the 25 country markets, stayed flat in one, and increased in the other 17 countries.
