Wash hands with soap and water before:

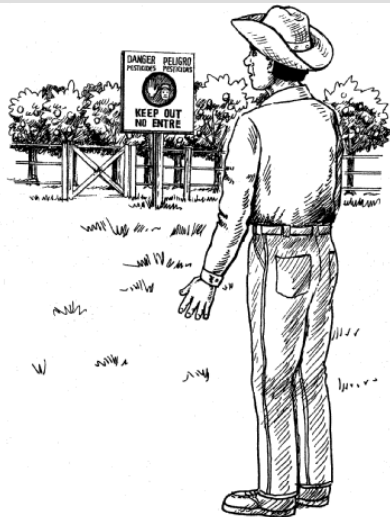
- Eating or drinking

- Chewing gum, smoking or chewing tobacco



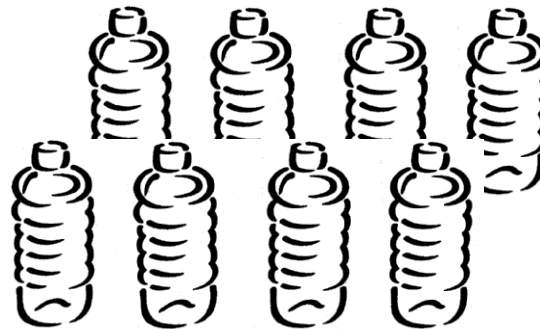
Take off boots and hat before entering home.



Do not enter recently sprayed fields.

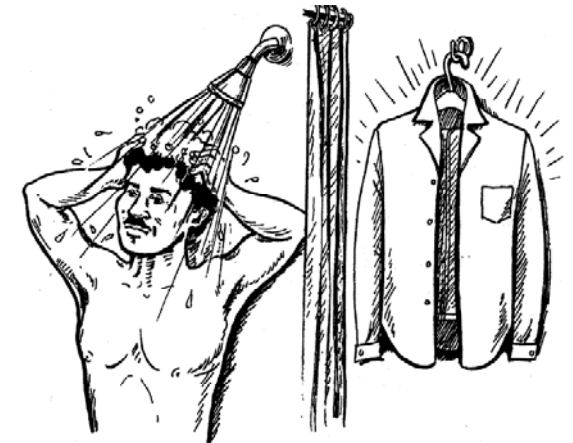


Drink 6-8 glasses of water every day.

WITH FAMILY...

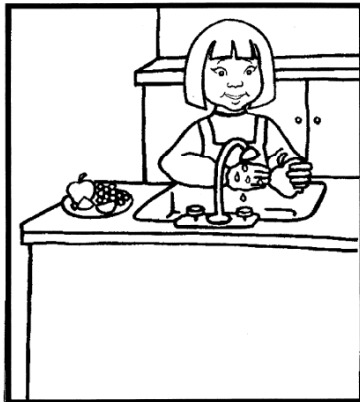
Do not allow children to play in fields or irrigation ditches.
