These projections are based on data currently available; however, these actions may be subject to change if situations arise to warrant modifications.

AD Work Plan for the Registration of Antimicrobial Pesticides

FY2004 and FY2005 New Chemical Registration Candidates

The Antimicrobials Division's FY2004 and FY2005 Work Plan identifies four new chemical candidates for decision-making during fiscal year 2004 and five new chemical candidates for decision-making during fiscal year 2005. The Agency anticipates making a registration decision for each of the nine candidates. These projections are based on the data currently available and are subject to change.

Antimicrobials Division Work Plan for the Reregistration of Antimicrobial Pesticides

FY2004 and FY2005 Candidates

The Antimicrobials Division Work Plan identifies eight reregistration cases for decision-making during FY 2004. Four of the eight candidates for reregistration are considered food-use chemicals (pine oils, phenol and salts, benzisothiazolin-3-one, and propylene/dipropylene glycol) and the remaining four are considered non-food use chemicals (pentachlorophenol, creosote, chromated arsenicals, and zinc omadine). For FY 2005, AD has scheduled eight reregistration candidates of which four are considered food-use (chlorine dioxide, iodine, 2 phenylphenol and salts, and sodium fluoride) and four are non-food use candidates (azadioxabicyclooctane, dihalodialkyldantoins, PHMB and oleic acid, sulfonates). It should be noted that sodium fluoride is a dual use chemical with AD being the lead division and SRRD providing risk assessments for the agricultural uses.

Pesticides which have both antimicrobial and agricultural uses are considered dual use pesticides. During FY2004, AD will provide exposure and/or risk assessments to address the antimicrobial uses for three reregistration cases which have dual uses. While these are the proposed candidates for decision-making, deviations may be made during the fiscal years as warranted.
