
Occupational Safety and Health Inspections

The purpose of this amendment is to reflect transfer of the Maritime Administration Occupational Safety and Health Program from the Division of Ship Management (Office of Ship Operations) to the Office of Management Services and Procurement.

Accordingly, the basic order is revised as follows:

Revise subsection 11.02 3 to read as follows:

- 3 If the dangerous exposure is in the Washington Headquarters facility, the responsible official shall notify the Safety Officer and request any necessary assistance. The Safety Officer shall notify the Director, Office of Management Services and Procurement and the Associate Administrator for Administration.
