MANUAL OF GENERAL PROCEDURES FOR DETERMINING SUBSTANTIALITY AND EXTENT OF FOREIGN-FLAG COMPETITION

## Section 1. Purpose:

This order authorizes the establishment and maintenance of a "Manual of General Procedures for Determining Substantiality and Extent of Foreignflag Competition," in accordance with Maritime Administrative Order 200-1. This Manual and any amendments thereof are a part of this order and shall have the full force and effect thereof.

## Section 2. Contents and Issuances of the Manual:

- 2.01 The "Manual of General Procedures for Determining Substantiality and Extent of Foreign-flag Competition," sets forth:
  - 1 The sources and nature of basic data required in determining the substantiality and extent of foreign-flag competition encountered by the holders of operating-differential subsidy contracts under Title VI of the Merchant Marine Act, 1936, as amended; and
  - 2 The factors involved and techniques used by the Maritime Subsidy Board/Maritime Administration in determining the substantiality and extent of foreign-flag competition.
- 2.02 Manual issuances shall be initiated by the Associate Administrator for Maritime Aids, and have the approval of the Maritime Subsidy Board/ Maritime Administrator.
- 2.03 The provisions of Maritime Administrative Orders relating to control of reporting requirements, forms, and publications shall be applicable in the preparation of Manual issuances submitted to the Maritime Subsidy Board/Maritime Administrator for approval.
