

Dear Mr. Pearson:

On July 7, 1987, a Notice of Hazardous Facility Order was issued to Williams Pipeline Company following a failure on the #1-6" Alexandria-Grand Forks pipeline in North Dakota. Following a hearing, on October 9, 1987, a Consent Order was issued in this case and later amended on January 22, 1990, June 26, 1992, August 3, 1994, and May 1, 1998. It required long term corrective action with respect to 52 line segments operated by Williams.

All actions required in this case have been completed. Based on the recommendation of the Director, Central Region, this case is now closed and no further compliance action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in the case. Thank you for your cooperation in our joint effort to ensure pipeline safety.
