The Fiscal Year 2008 Department of Transportation Appropriations Act directs the Office of Inspector General (OIG) to examine railroad service disruptions since 2004, in particular, incidents in which rail carriers failed to make shipments of commodities, such as coal, wheat, ethanol, and lumber in a timely manner. The Act also directs the OIG to make legislative and regulatory recommendations to reduce such disruptions in the future.

The objectives of this audit are to determine: (1) the standard of railroad service owed to selected shippers of commodities, such as coal, wheat, ethanol and lumber, either by regulation or by contract since 2004; (2) the timeliness and reliability of rail service provided to these shippers; and (3) the causes of any identified railroad service deficiencies to the selected shippers.

We will conduct this audit at the Federal Railroad Administration Headquarters in Washington, DC and at the offices of selected railroads. We will contact your audit liaison to schedule an entrance conference. Mitchell Behm is the Program Director and Betty Krier is the Program Manager for this audit.
