




#### **Organizational Structure**





- Plan for the long term needs of your organization and who it serves both internally and externally









#### HSI – What does it do?

- HSI Technology allows a sensor on a moving platform to detect reflected radiation (light) from objects on the ground.
- Algorithms allow ARCHER to:
  - Detect spectral anomalies (things that do not "belong")
  - Detect specific spectral signatures using matched filters (find things with known spectral properties)
  - Detect changes over time
- Algorithms are applied in real-time, and require little to no user input




## **HSI Operational Impact**




