LOCATION.--Lat 35°28'10", long 82°38'35" referenced to North American Datum of 1983, Buncombe County, NC, Hydrologic Unit 06010105, 1.2 mi north of Blue Ridge Parkway, 3.1 mi west of Brevard Road in Bent Creek Research Forest. Owner: NCDENR (North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources), Division of Water Quality.

**GROUND-WATER RECORDS**

WELL CHARACTERISTICS.--Drilled observation well, depth 24 ft, diameter 4 in., cased to 9 ft, screened interval from 9 to 24 ft, sand filter packed from 7 to 9 ft, natural fill from 9 to 24 ft.

DATUM.--Land-surface datum is 2,299.99 ft above National Geodetic Vertical Datum of 1929. Measuring point: top of steel casing, 3.01 ft above land-surface datum, Feb. 4, 2003, to present.

PERIOD OF RECORD.--February 2003 to current year.

GAGE.--Measured periodically with electric and steel tape.

REMARKS.--Well is part of Piedmont/Mountains ground-water study.

EXTREMES FOR PERIOD OF RECORD.--Highest water level measured, 3.19 ft below land-surface datum, July 3, 2003; lowest water level measured, 7.09 ft below land-surface datum, September 25, 2007.
