Title 3—Proclamation 7922 of September 4, 2005The PresidentDeath of William H. RehnquistBy the President of the United States of AmericaA ProclamationAs a mark of respect for William H. Rehnquist, Chief Justice of the United
States, I hereby order, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution
and laws of the United States of America, including section 7 of title
4, United States Code, that the flag of the United States shall be flown
at half-staff at the White House and on all public buildings and grounds,
at all military posts and paval stations and on all public buildings of the

at half-staff at the White House and on all public buildings and grounds, at all military posts and naval stations, and on all naval vessels of the Federal Government in the District of Columbia and throughout the United States and its Territories and possessions until sunset, Tuesday, September 13, 2005. I also direct that the flag shall be flown at half-staff for the same period at all United States embassies, legations, consular offices, and other facilities abroad, including all military facilities and naval vessels and stations.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand this fourth day of September, in the year of our Lord two thousand five, and of the Independence of the United States of America the two hundred and thirtieth.
