The Canadian Lumber Program monitor incoming lumber shipments into the United States with the help of U.S. Customs. This program was developed to address trade distortions resulting from alleged subsidies in the Canadian lumber market. Under Compliance Assistants and supervised by the Program Manager, the program process specific lumber import documents received from U.S. Customs and examines these documents for completeness and overall accuracy.

Canadian Lumber Export Notices – Custom entry documents for softwood lumber from Canada. Arrive in monthly succession. Used for statistical purposes. Transfer files at end of calendar year. Destroy when 5 years old.
