

## Custom Maps and Reports on Floods in Iowa


- This package covers custom analyses on flood-impacted Census blocks in the Cedar Rapids and Des Moines areas.
- For each city, one map and two sets of reports are provided. The map shows a city, rivers
  and streams near or in the city, and a set of Census blocks defined as the Area of
  Analysis. The reports include characteristics of workers employed or living in the
  selected Census blocks, as well as work locations of for the Census block's residents and
  home locations for the Census block's workers.
- The area of analysis was defined by selecting all Census blocks up to 0.5 miles away from any water source that is within 5 miles of the Des Moines or Cedar Rapids city boundary.
- Data source: U.S. Census Bureau, LED Worker Origin/Destination Database (2nd Quarter of 2002, 2003 and 2004).
- The base map geographies (including city boundaries, Census blocks, and water sources) used in this analysis are based on TIGER 2005 2nd Edition geovintage.
- These custom maps and reports are generated using ESRI's ArcGIS and SAS.

## Potential Flood Areas Near Des Moines, Iowa



This map shows a potential flood analysis area surrounding Des Moines, Iowa. The shaded area represents the Census Blocks that lie within 1/2 mile of any river, stream, or waterway near to Des Moines. The following reports use this shaded region as the Area of Analysis. In and around Des Moines, there are 4435 Census Blocks being used for the analysis. Gauge markers identify approximate locations of USGS river gauges.

The choice of parameters (any waterway within 5 miles of Des Moines and any Census Block within 0.5 miles of those chose waterways) are not fixed. Any detailed geography that can be approximated by Census Blocks can be used for this analysis.


