


Standard Maps and Reports on Floods in Iowa

- This package covers four flood-impacted cities Burlington, Cedar Rapids, Des Moines, and Iowa City and one tornado-impacted city (Parkersburg);
- The results are generated directly from OnTheMap, located at http://lehd.did.census.gov, by using a standard Internet browser.
- For each city, three maps and four reports are provided.
- The maps include
 - o A reference map of each city,
 - o A map showing where workers employed in each city live, and
 - o A map showing where resident-workers living in each city are employed.
- The reports include
 - o Characteristics of workers employed or living in each city,
 - Work locations of each city's residents and home locations for each city's workers.
- The points displayed in the Labor and Commute Shed maps represent workers' employment locations or residential locations. Each point represents a single Census block. The size of each point is based upon the number of workers living or working in that block, and value ranges are shown in the bottom left corner of the map. Census blocks with no worker/resident do not display a point.
- Data source: U.S. Census Bureau, LED Worker Origin/Destination Database (2nd Quarter of 2002, 2003 and 2004).
- The base map geographies (including city boundaries and water sources) used in this analysis are based on TIGER 2005 2nd Edition geovintage.




Burlington, IA – Labor Shed Map Where Workers Employed in Burlington Live (2004)








Cedar Rapids, IA — Labor Shed Map Where Workers Employed in Cedar Rapids Live (2004)






Des Moines, IA – Labor Shed Map








Iowa City, IA – Labor Shed Map Where Workers Employed in Iowa City Live (2004)








Parkersburg, IA — Labor Shed Map Where Workers Employed in Parkersburg Live (2004)
