

NOTES to Table and Chart:

- Because expenditure amounts for individual responder categories were not available, this proration
 assumes that the amount spent in each category is proportional to the number of responders trained.
- 2) "Other" category responders may include public works personnel, LEPC members acting as auditaries, emergency response center personnel, and so forth. For FY 1993, responder group identification was unavailable from the figures submitted by many states, and therefore many responders, including fire and police personnel, were included in the "Other Training" category.
- 3) FY 93 figures reflect funds available from two registration fee collection periods.
- 4) Figures on responders trained in FY 96 are expected to be available by 12/31/97. The grant amount for all training categories in FY 96 is \$3.8 million.
