 2/ Under Section 2104(d)(3)(B) of the Act, as amended by DRA, \$2,971,500, calculated as 1.05 percent of the \$283,000,000, is available for the Jurisdictions.  
 3/ The total amount available for additional allotments to eliminate States' shortfalls is \$280,026,500, calculated as \$283,000,000 minus \$2,971,500 (the amount available for allotment to the Jurisdictions).  
 4/ Additional allotments to eliminate States' shortfalls in Column G do not exceed shortfalls in Column E and are available for targeted low-income children expenditures in Column F.
