

BACT/LAER Guidance

- Initiative to reduce permitting burden for Tier 2 projects;
- EPA will identify generally acceptable control technology for certain refinery units and pollutants--
 - NOx emissions from Refinery Heaters;
 - VOC emissions from Refinery Equipment;
- BACT & LAER remain case-by-case determinations.

Offset Guidance

- Initiative to provide support for use of Tier 2 reductions as NSR offsets;
- Guidance addresses creditability of Tier 2 reductions;
- Does not ensure availability of offsets;
- States must decide on how they will use available Tier 2 reductions.

- Public review of draft guidance via web site and Federal Register;

- National Team + Regional Teams
- Encourage S/L agencies & refiners to identify potential issues early;

 - track permitting issues
 - monitor progress of permitting activities
 - assist in issue resolution
 - technical support as needed

- EPA Regional Permitting Teams
 - NSR, EJ expertise directly available to S/L permitting authorities
 - technical assistance to refineries as needed
 - outreach and educational projects to communities as needed

Environmental Justice (continued)

- EJ "Communications Package"
 - Tier 2 benefits estimates
 - Demographic/socioeconomic data for communities around affected refinery
 - Emission estimates (recomm provided by refinery)
 - Additional information--working with NEJAC to enhance community understanding
