Total persons in Column 4 include people who reported two or more American Indian or Alaska Native tribes and at least one or more other races. For example, a respondent who reported as both Fort Sill Apache and Mescalero Apache and as "White and Black or African American American Indian or Alaska Native" would be counted in both the Fort Sill Apache and Mescalero Apache data lines once, counted in the Total Apache data line once, counted in the Total persons once, and counted twice in the Total tribes tallied data line.

Total persons in Column 5 include a tally of responses for people who reported one or more American Indian or Alaska Native tribe(s) and one or more races. For example, a respondent who reported as both Fort Sill Apache and Mescalero Apache and as "White **and** Black or African American **and** American Indian or Alaska Native" would be counted in both the Fort Sill and Mescalero data lines once, counted in the Total Apache data line once, counted in the Total persons dataline once, and counted twice in the Total tribes tallied data line.
