Total persons in Column 3 include people who reported one American Indian or Alaska Native tribe, or who checked the American Indian or Alaska Native response category, but did not write-in a specified tribe, and who reported at least one other race. These races include White, Black or African American, Asian, Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and Some other race. For example, a respondent who reported as both "White **and** American Indian and Alaska Native," and wrote in Fort Sill Apache, would be counted once each in the Fort Sill Apache data line, in the Total Apache data line, in the Total persons data line, and in the Total tribes tallied data line.

Total persons in Column 4 include people who reported two or more American Indian or Alaska Native tribes and at least one or more other races. For example, a respondent who reported as both Fort Sill Apache and Mescalero Apache and as "White and Black or African American American Indian or Alaska Native" would be counted in both the Fort Sill Apache and Mescalero Apache data lines once, counted in the Total Apache data line once, counted in the Total persons once, and counted twice in the Total tribes tallied data line.

Total persons in Column 5 include a tally of responses for people who reported one or more American Indian or Alaska Native tribe(s) and one or more races. For example, a respondent who reported as both Fort Sill Apache and Mescalero Apache and as "White and Black or African American and American Indian or Alaska Native" would be counted in both the Fort Sill and Mescalero data lines once, counted in the Total Apache data line once, counted in the Total persons dataline once, and counted twice in the Total tribes tallied data line.

¹ The number and percent for Total American Indian and Alaska Native tribes tallied do not add to the total American Indian and Alaska Native population. This is because respondents may have reported more than one tribe.
