1. GRANTEE: General Oil Equipment Co., Inc.
Tonawanda, New York

- 2. <u>PURPOSE AND LIMITATION</u>: This exemption authorizes the transportation in commerce of residual amounts of certain liquid petroleum products in a non-DOT specification tank. This exemption provides no relief from any regulation other than as specifically stated herein.
- 3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
- 4. <u>REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED</u>: 49 CFR Part 173.24(c)(1) and 173.242 in that a non-DOT specification packaging is authorized.
- 5. <u>BASIS</u>: This exemption is based on the application of General Oil Equipment Co., Inc. dated May 1, 1991, and supplemental engineering information dated April 13, 1995, submitted in accordance with 49 CFR 107.103 and the public proceeding thereon.
- 6. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (49 CFR 172.101):

7. PACKAGING AND SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:

- a. PACKAGING Packaging consists of a non-DOT specification cylindrical tank fabricated from U.S. Standard Gauge No. 7 mild steel and is used in meter proofing. This tank is permanently mounted to a truck chassis with its central axis vertical, as shown in the sketch submitted as part of the application. Supports and anchoring must comply with § 178.340-6 as published in the 1990 revision of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations.
- b. <u>TESTING</u> This packaging must be subjected to all tests and inspections required for a MC 306 cargo tank in accordance with § 180.407.
- c. <u>OPERATIONAL CONTROLS</u> When not engaged in meter proofing operations, the tank must be drained of liquid hazardous residue to a level of less than 1 gallon.

8. <u>SPECIAL PROVISIONS</u>:

- a. Shippers using the packaging covered by this exemption must comply with all provisions of this exemption, and all other applicable requirements contained in 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
- b. MARKING The tank must be marked on each side "DOT-E 10606" in letters and numbers at least 2-inches in height on a contrasting background.
- 9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle.

10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS:

A copy of this exemption must be carried aboard each motor vehicle used to transport packages covered by this exemption.

- 11. <u>COMPLIANCE</u>: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this exemption and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. Section 5101 et seq:
 - o All terms and conditions prescribed in this exemption and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
 - o Registration required by 49 CFR 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

No person may use or apply this exemption, including display of its number, when the exemption has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: The carrier is required to report 12. any incident involving loss of packaging contents or packaging failure to the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety (AAHMS) as soon as practicable. (49 CFR 171.15 and 171.16 apply to any activity undertaken under the authority of this exemption.) In addition, the holder(s) of this exemption must inform the AAHMS, in writing, of any incidents involving the package and shipments made under the terms of this exemption.
