ALMOST ONE IN EVERY SEVEN SOUTH DAKOTA RESIDENTS IS A  
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF SOUTH DAKOTA HAS  
REACHED AN ESTIMATED 108-THOUSAND. AMERICAN INDIANS AND  
ALASKA NATIVES REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE,  
WITH ALMOST 72-THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS HISPANICS, WITH  
18-THOUSAND-FIVE-HUNDRED PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS  
REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS SECOND. FOR
