ANNOUNCER:

MORE THAN THREE IN EVERY TEN ALABAMA RESIDENTS IS A  
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF ALABAMA HAS  
REACHED AN ESTIMATED ONE-POINT-FIVE MILLION. BLACKS  
REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH ONE-POINT-  
TWO MILLION PEOPLE. SECOND WAS HISPANICS, WITH 125-THOUSAND  
PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY
