AMERICAN INDIANS AND ALASKA NATIVES REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH 122-THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS ASIANS, WITH 41-THOUSAND PEOPLE.
