ANNOUNCER:

MORE THAN THREE IN EVERY TEN ALASKA RESIDENTS IS A  
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF ALASKA HAS  
REACHED AN ESTIMATED 232-THOUSAND. AMERICAN INDIANS AND  
ALASKA NATIVES REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE,  
WITH 122-THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS ASIANS, WITH  
41-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS REMAIN THE  
LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS SECOND. FOR MORE
