MORE THAN FOUR IN EVERY TEN ARIZONA RESIDENTS IS A MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF ARIZONA HAS REACHED AN ESTIMATED TWO-POINT-SIX MILLION. HISPANICS REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH ONE-POINT-NINE-MILLION PEOPLE. SECOND WAS AMERICAN INDIANS AND ALASKA NATIVES, WITH 335-THOUSAND PEOPLE.
