NATIVE HAWAIINS AND OTHER PACIFIC ISLANDERS REPRESENT THE SECOND-LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH 269-THOUSAND PEOPLE. THIRD WAS HISPANICS, WITH 105-THOUSAND PEOPLE.
