MORE THAN TWO IN EVERY TEN MICHIGAN RESIDENTS IS A MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF MICHIGAN HAS REACHED AN ESTIMATED TWO-POINT-THREE MILLION. BLACKS REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH ONE-POINT-FIVE MILLION PEOPLE. SECOND WAS HISPANICS, WITH 403-THOUSAND PEOPLE.
