AMERICAN INDIANS AND ALASKA NATIVES REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH 71-THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS HISPANICS, WITH 27-THOUSAND PEOPLE.
