MORE THAN ONE IN EVERY THREE NEW JERSEY RESIDENTS IS A MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF NEW JERSEY HAS REACHED AN ESTIMATED THREE-POINT-THREE-MILLION. HISPANICS REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH ALMOST ONE-POINT-FOUR-MILLION PEOPLE. SECOND WAS BLACKS, WITH ONE-POINT-THREE-MILLION PEOPLE.
