HISPANICS REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH ALMOST 38-THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS AMERICAN INDIANS AND ALASKA NATIVES, WITH ALMOST 17-THOUSAND PEOPLE.
