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## WASHINGTON REDSKINS LEGEND TO SPEAK AT GPO

### **WHO:**

Ken Harvey, retired All-Pro linebacker with the Washington Redskins and former President of the Washington Redskins Alumni Association, will address U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) employees as part of the Combined Federal Campaign (CFC). Harvey was signed by the Redskins as a free agent in 1994. He led the NFC in sacks and was second in the NFL. Harvey was named to four consecutive Pro Bowls in the 1990s. Since his retirement from the gridiron, Harvey started his own marketing/government relations company, JAKA Consulting. He is also a motivational speaker and author of children's books. Harvey currently works with the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, AOL, The Washington Post and Comcast SportsNet.

### **WHAT:**

Harvey will discuss his background and the importance of giving to charities. He has been an active member of the Washington D.C. community for 13 years. The CFC is the annual fundraising drive conducted by Federal employees in their workplace. The CFC is organized into more than 285 independent geographic campaigns (GPO is part the National Capital Area campaign). Last year, Federal employees and military personnel contributed \$271.6 million nationwide through the CFC to benefit not-for-profit charities. No other annual employee-giving program raises as much money for charity. President John F. Kennedy initiated a formal national giving program for Federal workers in 1961.
