A Corrective Action Order was issued on February 7, 2003 by the Associate Administrator for Pipeline Safety in the above-referenced case. It required you to take certain corrective actions to protect the public and environment from potential hazards associated with your Southwest Mainline pipeline which extends from Mainline Valve 44 in Mercer County, Illinois to the New Windsor Compressor Station in Henry County, Illinois.
