**EXPLANATION**

- TRAIL, OR ROAD—Dashed where approximately located, solid where colored. Routes shown from aerial photographs. General Land Office plots, or early maps. Most trail or road names are from original sources such as land plats or government road charts. Most early road and trail maps are shown. Some trails are indicated where not located on aerial photographs. The 1870 indicates that routes were General Land Office routes of 1870.
- UNIDENTIFIED CULTURAL FEATURE—Approximately located showing in parentheses after name and approximate date of founding of a town or establishment of a post office, and the date of the first post-office. Most town names, especially those towns not shown on later maps. Location of towns shown on previously published maps may vary and locations noted here may be inaccurate.
- RAILROAD—Abandoned and dismantled, graded but not now used or corrected and never graded. Date shown beginning or duration of operation. Operating railroad are shown on base. For more detail about railroads, see Hays, (1962).

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
