
FINAL ORDER

On January 28, 1995, Respondent was criminally convicted in New York of a serious crime. Thereafter, based upon the New York criminal conviction, Respondent was automatically disbarred in New York on January 28, 1995. In March, 1999, the Supreme Court of Florida reciprocally suspended Respondent, based upon the New York disbarment, and in April 1999, entered a final reciprocal suspension order. On or about September 20, 2000, the United States District Court, Southern District of Florida, disbarred Respondent reciprocally based upon the Florida Supreme Court order.

The General Counsel for the Executive Office for Immigration Review has met its burden of proof by clear, convincing and unequivocal evidence as to the New York criminal conviction and subsequent suspension or disbarment orders based thereon.

Respondent, having knowingly waived his right to challenge the Notice of Intent to Discipline under 8 C.F.R. § 3.103(b)(1) and (2)(i)-(iii) and rebut the presumption of reciprocal

discipline, and based upon the agreement of the parties on this date, it is hereby ORDERED that Respondent be suspended indefinitely from practice before the Board of Immigration Appeals, the Immigration Courts, and the Immigration and Naturalization Service, until further order of the Court or the Board of Immigration Appeals.




