

ORDER OF DISCIPLINE

The Motion for Summary Decision of the Immigration and Naturalization Service having been granted by the Immigration Judge at a hearing on September 8, 1997, the Respondent, freely and knowingly, stipulated to the discipline requested in the Motion. The Court, being fully advised in this matter, approved the stipulation and hereby enters the following order of discipline in this matter:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. David S. Sabghir be suspended from practice before the Immigration and Naturalization Service and the Executive Office for Immigration Review, to include the Immigration Courts nationwide and the Board of Immigration Appeals, for a period of six months beginning September 8, 1997;
- 2. David S. Sabghir may not be reinstated to practice before the Immigration and Naturalization Service and the Executive Office for Immigration Review, to include the Immigration Courts nationwide and the Board of Immigration Appeals, until such time as he is reinstated to the practice of law, and in good standing, in the State of New York, and any other jurisdictions in which he is subsequently disciplined; and

3. In order to be reinstated to practice before the Immigration and Naturalization Service and the Executive Office for Immigration Review, to include the Immigration Courts nationwide and the Board of Immigration Appeals, David S. Sabghir must seek the approval of the Immigration Court by filing a Motion for Reinstatement to Practice.
